**Duties include**

- Manage the Marmotte club between 11.30 and 4.15pm Monday to Friday including planning the itinerary for the week and communicating the plan to your Marmotte team
- Communicate meal requirements to the daily lunch venue and monitor the quality
- Keep up to date and accurate records on a daily basis for all children in the club
- Communicate any issues to your Resort Management
- Assist in covering Chalet Host and other resort duties when Marmotte club not running
- Assist Chalet Teams on changeover days and with new guest arrivals in the ski shop on Sunday and help with lesson arrangements on Monday mornings
