What will you have to do?

You are responsible for managing the delivery of all guests ski packs when they arrive, and liaising with our Snowtime partners (ski schools, lift pass company and equipment shop) each week to confirm bookings and collect relevant vouchers in advance of the guests' arrival.

You will manage the stock control in each chalet, ensuring that the chalet teams are following procedures and processes, highlighting any discrepancies, and making sure each chalet has sufficient stocks to deliver a quality service to guests at all times.

Duties include (but are not limited to)

Ski pack preparation
Timely delivery of information to each chalet team
Managing stocks in each chalet
Managing guest accounts for in-resort purchases
Entering feedback and preparing a weekly report
Assisting with providing shuttle services to guests
